Day 1 • Depart for Egypt

Our journey begins as we board our flight to Egypt. **INF**

Day 2 • Cairo

Welcome to Egypt, one of the world's greatest ancient civilizations. We arrive in Cairo, meet our 4-Season's Travel representative and transfer to our hotel. Tonight, we attend the Sound & Light Show, a dramatic presentation with the famous pyramids of Giza in the background. The show takes us back to ancient Egypt and tells the story of the pyramids narrated by famous personalities. **INF**

Day 3 • Cairo

Today, we start our tour at the Grand Egyptian Museum, a neoclassical building located on Tahir Square. The museum houses the world's largest collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts with more than 120,000 items on display including the many colossal Statues of the Great Pharaohs in the Main Hall. Our tour manager points out some of the more interesting artifacts and brings their stories to life. Also included is a ticket to see the Collection of the Golden Boy-King Tutankhamun, with pieces displayed for the first time since its discovery a century ago. We enjoy lunch at Restaurant 139 with direct views of the Great Pyramid. After lunch, we have a tour of the Mena House Palace and learn of its history and significance. **B/L**

Day 4 • Cairo

After a hearty breakfast, we visit the famous Pyramids of Giza, built during the 3rd and 4th dynasties of the Old Kingdom. Enjoy an up-close view of the Great Pyramid, built for the Pharaoh Khufu, as well as the Pyramids of Khafre and Menkaure. The Great Pyramid rises 450 feet in the air and covers 13 acres of land. We ride camels into the nearby desert for a different view. Not far from the Pyramids, we see the Mythical Sphinx of Giza, the legendary statue with the head of a human and the body of a lion, amazingly carved out of one huge piece of limestone. It demonstrates the Power and Divinity of the Pharaoh. We have a BBQ lunch before continuing to Sakkara and the Step Pyramid. At 4700 years old, it is the first Pyramid and the oldest construction of stone in the whole world and was a revolutionary construction technique for Royal tombs. We also observe wall carvings with daily life activities depicted on the Nobel Tombs. You may have the opportunity to explore the Pharaoh's Burial chamber. We stop for a visit at a famous Carpet School. After time for shopping, we return to our hotel for a relaxing evening on our own. **B/L**

Day 5 • Aswan

Our day begins with a flight to Aswan. Upon arrival, we have the remainder of the morning at leisure in this ancient frontier town. This afternoon, we enjoy a Felucca (sailboat) ride on the Nile River where we see plants, birds and rocky islands along the shore. We meet in the evening for an included dinner at the New Movenpick Hotel. **B/D**

Day 6 • Nile Cruise

Today, we may join the optional Abu Simbel tour. A flight from Aswan transports us back in time to the mighty Temple of Abu Simbel, reclaimed from the floodwaters of the Aswan High Dam and totally reconstructed by UNESCO in the present location. The site is dominated by the looming twin temples of Ramses II and his wife Queen Nefertari. It is one of the most recognizable and unique ancient sites of Egypt. We fly back to Aswan and transfer to our cruise ship for lunch and settle into our home for the next three nights. We have free time in the afternoon to explore the Spice Markets of Aswan. **B/L/D**

Day 7 • Nile Cruise

After breakfast, we take a tour to Philae Temple dedicated to the goddess Isis, and marvel at the temple's lovely island location with its tropical trees and flowers. While there, learn about the legend of Isis & Osiris and see carvings of the Kings of Ancient Egypt depicting the myths of creation before continuing to the beautiful Botanical Garden of Aswan. In the afternoon, our Nile cruise sets sail for an unforgettable journey on the legendary Nile River. Our first stop is the Temple of Kom Ombo, dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek and the sky god Horus and depicting reliefs of the ancient medical instruments and the calendar. We continue sailing to Edfu where we dock for the evening. Tonight, enjoy an Egyptian Galabiya Night (Dress Party) with Egyptian food, music, dancing and fun. **B/L/D**

Day 8 • Nile Cruise

We visit the Temple of Edfu on horse carriages and explore the best-preserved temple of the ancient world. Built for Horus, the falcon God of the Sky, the temple was built entirely during the Greek era of Egypt. We return to the Nile cruise and sail via the lock of Esna to Luxor, known in ancient Egyptian times as the city of Thebes. During sailing, we have a chat on Egypt and the Nile Valley and its water problems and plans. **B/L/D**



Day 9 • Luxor

Today, we take a sightseeing tour of the East Bank of Luxor. We visit the magnificent Temples of Karnak, dating back over 3,000 years. Walking along the avenue of the Sphinxes, we marvel at the Hypostyle Hall with its 134 massive sandstone columns built by Ramses II and see the sacred lake and many temples. Then we continue to the Temple of Luxor built for the Harem of the God Amun Ra and have lunch nearby. Our afternoon is free for shopping and exploring in Luxor. **B/L**

Day 10 • Luxor

After breakfast, we visit the UNESCO listed Valley of the Kings, the necropolis of Thebes and admire the tombs of ancient Egypt's rulers. There are 65 tombs located in the small valley, and we stop at three of the most beautiful tombs plus the King Tut Tomb with his Mummy. Next, we head to the Temple of Hatshepsut, a colonnaded structure surrounded by cliffs and learn about the life of the strong Queen Hatshepsut, Egypt's first female ruler. After a visit at the Alabaster house, we drive by the new discovery of the Lost Golden City and conclude our tour at the Colossi of Memnon: two massive stone statues of the Pharaoh Amenhotep III. Next, we stop in the Valley of the Queens and enjoy a special visit at the Tomb of Queen Nefertari, wife of King Ramses the Great, and arguably the most beautiful tomb in the world. We return to the hotel and have a free afternoon to explore the island and enjoy the marvelous sunset. Later we enjoy pizza at the hotel. **B/D**

Day 11 • Cairo

This morning we fly to Cairo and continue to Old Cairo to visit the church of Abu Serga with crypts where the Holy family stayed during their period of exile. We also visit the Ben Ezra Jewish Synagogue and the Hanging Church. We check into our hotel. **B/D**

Day 12 • Return Home

We transfer to Cairo International Airport for our departure flight back home. We return with amazing memories of our wonderful tour of Egypt. **B**
