Day 1: Friday, May 17, 2024 • Depart

Our journey begins as we board our flight to Washington DC. Upon landing, we are met by our tour guide and enjoy a panoramic tour of the city on our way into the city. After a stop for lunch on our own, we tour the monuments of the Tidal Basin and nearby areas. We stop at the Lincoln, FDR, WWII, Korean War and Vietnam War memorial, along with bridges, statues and other historical markers. We check into our hotel with some time on our own before a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. **(D)**

Day 2: Saturday, May 18, 2024 • Washington, DC - Mount Vernon

After breakfast, we head out of the city to Mount Vernon, the estate of George Washington. It's here that he escaped the rigor of public office and enjoyed the life of a successful Virginia planter. This southern plantation standing on the banks of the Potomac River details the life of the "Father of Our Country" while providing fascinating insights into colonial times. We visit the orientation center and museums at Mount Vernon as well as the estate and gardens. Returning to the city, we have a panoramic tour of Washington DC's most famous buildings, with photo stops at the White House and Capital Hill. This evening we have dinner on our own. **(B)**

Day 3: Sunday, May 19, 2024 • Washington, DC

The Smithsonian Institute is a comprehensive collection of twenty-one museums, most with no entrance fees. This morning, we have a guided tour of the American History Museum and the National Portrait Gallery. This afternoon, we are free to explore the city on our own, perhaps taking in other museums, gardens or the zoo. Dinner is on our own. **(B)**

Day 4: Monday, May 20, 2024 • Fredericksburg – Yorktown - Williamsburg

We depart for historic Fredericksburg after breakfast. It is here that a bloody engagement of the Civil War took place in December of 1862. We meet our guide to tour the battlefield and learn the history. We drive to Yorktown and travel a bit further back in history to the Revolutionary War. We learn about the siege at Yorktown then explore the museum which includes portions of the headquarters' tents that George Washington used with a local expert. We

continue our drive to Williamsburg. We enjoy dinner and an evening walk in the historically reconstructed town. **(B, D)**

Day 5: Tuesday, May 21, 2024 • Williamsburg

After breakfast at the hotel, we tour the Powhatan Indian Village, a recreation of the native American village located near the Jamestown Settlement. Then we visit historic Jamestown and board one of the ships copied from the original three that landed in America in 1607. We have free time to explore the historic center before returning to Williamsburg. This evening we have a colonial-style dinner at a historic tavern in the evening. **(B, D)**

Day 6: Wednesday, May 22, 2024 • Richmond - Albemarle County

We depart for Richmond, VA, one of America's oldest cities. We tour the historic district with a local guide, including the church where Patrick Henry declared "Give me liberty or give me death", and the home (now a museum) of Jefferson Davis, the President of the Confederacy during the Civil War. This afternoon, we tour Monticello, the estate of Thomas Jefferson. We check into our hotel for a relaxed dinner as a group. **(B, D)**

Day 7: Thursday, May 23, 2024 • Harpers Ferry - Gettysburg

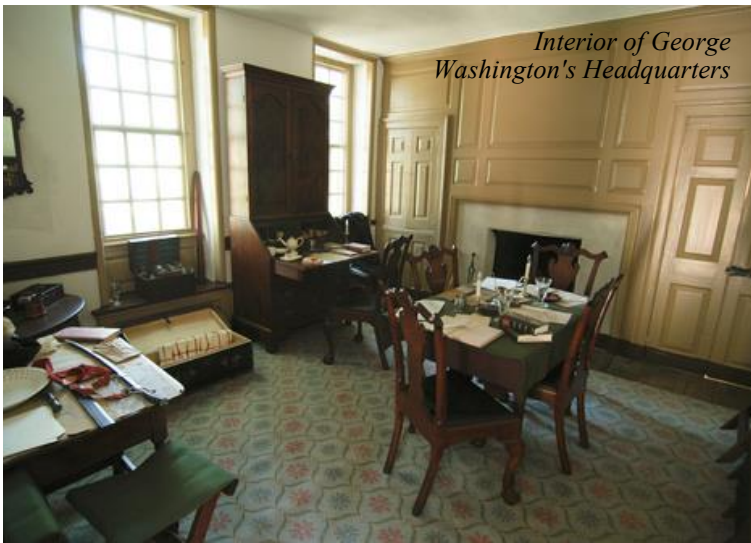
We depart for Harpers Ferry where the Potomac and Shenandoah rivers meet. We visit the National Historic Park, with 19th century buildings, a Civil War Museum and John Brown Fort. This afternoon we arrive in Gettysburg for a guided tour at the National Military Park and Museum. We check into our hotel and freshen up before a candlelit dinner at Dobbin House tavern. **(B, D)**

Day 8: Friday, May 24, 2024 • Gettysburg

We continue our exploration of historic Gettysburg today. We visit the iconic Cyclorama painting of the climactic confederate attack on the Union Forces. We tour the Seminary Ridge Museum for an inside look of the battle. Later, we go to downtown Gettysburg for free time and dinner on our own. **(B)**

Day 9: Saturday, May 25, 2024 • Valley Forge - Philadelphia

On our drive to Philadelphia, we stop at the Valley Forge

National Historical Park, where General Washington and his Continental Army stayed the long winter of 1777-78. We continue our drive to Philadelphia, where we have a guided tour of the Franklin Institute. We end the day at our hotel. Dinner is on our own. **(B)**

Day 10: Sunday, May 26, 2024 • Philadelphia

Today we have a guided tour to see the historic treasures of the “City of Brotherly Love”, including the Liberty Bell, Independence Hall, and other noteworthy sights in what is considered America’s most historic mile. We have the rest of the day for free time, with options including the Elfreth’s Alley for a look into a historic town, Spruce Street Harbor Park with an active nightlife or the reading terminal market for renowned specialty eats. **(B)**

Day 11: Monday, May 27, 2024 • Return

This morning we tour the Philadelphia Museum of Art before we head to the Philadelphia International Airport for our return flight home. **(B)**

All cancellations must be in writing. The date of postmark will determine the amount of refund due. Refunds are based on the number of days prior to departure date. From the time of deposit to 90 days before departure a \$100/person administrative fee plus any land penalties will be assessed. From 89 - 30 days before departure, a \$300/person cancellation penalty plus lost airfare deposits and any unrecoverable deposits to ground suppliers will be assessed. Anyone canceling less than 30 days prior to departure will receive no refund.

Purchase of health, baggage, and trip cancellation/interruption insurance is strongly recommended.

Terms and Conditions

We reserve the right to cancel this trip due to lack of subscription.
