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Monday, October 26, 2015 • Depart

Our adventure begins as we depart on our transatlantic flight to Rome, Italy. **IF**

Tuesday, October 27, 2015 • Rome

After clearing customs we meet our guide and board coach for a tour to see the glories of the Caesars, the awe that is St. Peter's and the city that was the birthplace for much of our civilization. We visit to the **Roman Colosseum** and the historic **Forum**, once the center of ancient Rome. Then we stop for lunch before we check in to our hotel. Dinner is own tonight. **L**

Wed., Oct. 28, 2015 • Rome - San Giovanni Rotondo

This morning our local guide joins us for a tour of Vatican City and St. Peter's Cathedral, home of the Roman Catholic Church and the world's largest Christian building. Included in our tour will be visits to the Vatican Museum and the Sistine Chapel. After our tour we head for San Giovanni Rotondo where dinner is at our hotel tonight. **B, D**



Thursday, October 29, 2015 • San Giovanni Rotondo



Today we explore the Region of Puglia to reach San Giovanni Rotondo, one of the most renowned pilgrimage destinations in Europe because of the extraordinary life and reputation for sanctity of the Franciscan Capuchin Priest,

Padre Pio da Pietralcina, who lived, labored, and in 1968 died here. We pray in the convent of Santa Maria delle Grazie where Padre Pio lived and afterwards hear about his life and works from the Franciscan friars, as we visit the institutions he left behind. Dinner tonight is in a local restaurant. **B, D**

Friday, October 30, 2015 • Sorrento

After Mass this morning at San Giovanni, we travel to nearby

Monte Sant'Angelo, one of the most ancient of Christian shrines, dedicated to the Archangel Michael who appeared here in the 5th and 8th centuries. We move across the Italian Peninsula towards Sorrento, stopping in **Pietrelcina** where Padre Pio was born and baptized. We overnight in beautiful Sorrento. **B, D**



Saturday, October 31, 2015 • Pompeii – Palermo, Sicily



We drive to **Pompeii** on the Mediterranean Sea and pray in the famous shrine dedicated to Our Lady of the Rosary. We have a **guided visit to the ruins of the Roman city** destroyed by Mt. Vesuvius. Late this afternoon we fly from

Naples to Palermo where we have dinner at our hotel. **B, D**

Sunday, November 1, 2015 • Palermo

Our day begins with a local guide and a driving tour of Palermo before driving the northern coastline to the seaside medieval village of **Cefalu**. We can stroll the Arabic streets of this fresh-faced fishing port. A mighty Norman-Arab-Byzantine



cathedral shimmers inside with Byzantine mosaics. View the Temple of Diana said to be one of the oldest structures still standing in Sicily. We enjoy a relaxing lunch at a beachfront restaurant and some free time before returning to Palermo for the evening. **B, L**

Monday, November 2, 2015 • Agrigento

Leaving Palermo, we travel south to a city made famous by "The Godfather," **Corleone**. A short visit to the **Anti-Mafia Museum** is followed by a tour and tasting lunch at a local vineyard, **Principe di Corleone**. We then continue to the southern coastline of Sicily to explore the ancient **Greek ruins of Agrigento**. Here a local guide will join us as we walk

thru the **Valley of the Temples** and view some of the best-preserved Greek temples in the world. Later, we overnight in view of the illuminated ruins. **B, L**

Tuesday, November 3, 2015 • Catania

Our route now takes us east to Piazza Armerina, where we stop to tour **Villa del Casale**, perhaps the most important surviving documentation of Roman presence in Sicily. Built between the 3rd and 4th century by a patrician family the total surface is more than 3500 square meters with 40 rooms, almost all of them paved with mosaic floors. For our final days we overnight in Catania on the most easterly shore of Sicily. Dinner is at our hotel tonight. **B, D**



Wednesday, November 4, 2015 • Catania

Our excursion today takes to **Siracusa**. In Siracusa our local guide accompanies us on visits to the **Greek theatre and Roman Colosseum** and other historical sites of the area. After lunch and free time for exploring on our own we return to Catania. **B, L**

Thursday, November 5, 2015 • Catania

A special day awaits us as we make our way past the foothills of Mt. Etna to the scenic coastal city of **Taormina**. There will be plenty of time to explore such sites as Giardini Pubblico (Public Garden) and the Greek Theater as well as shop for unique treasures to take home. On our return to Catania we stop in the area of Mt. Etna at Gambino winery for dinner and a tasting of their wines. **B, D**



Friday, November 6, 2015 • Return to USA

Sadly it is time to end our Sicilian adventure as we transfer to the airport for our flights home. We are filled, however, with lasting impressions of Italy and the island of Sicily. Arrivederci! **B, IF**

Payment Schedule:

A deposit of \$500 per person is due with reservation. Final payment is due 100 days prior to departure date. Invoice will be sent out prior to final payment. Passengers may add after this date subject to air and land availability. Generally airlines do not increase the price of a ticket after it has been contracted. However, prior to the issuance of a ticket, airlines may (and regularly do) impose fuel, tax, or security surcharges. In the event a surcharge is imposed after Ed-Ventures has received a final payment, Ed-Ventures will send an additional invoice for the surcharge amount. Early registration is encouraged.

Currency:

Currency exchange rates fluctuate constantly. In the event of a significant drop in the value of the dollar, we reserve the right to add a currency surcharge to the price of the tour.

Refund/Cancellation Policy:

All cancellations must be in writing. The date of postmark will determine the amount of refund due. Refunds are based on the number of days prior to departure date. From the time of deposit to 99 days before departure a \$100 administrative fee plus any airfare penalties will be assessed. From 99-14 days, a \$300 cancellation penalty plus lost airfare deposits and any unrecoverable deposits to ground suppliers will be assessed. Airline tickets once purchased are nonrefundable. Anyone canceling less than 14 days prior to departure will receive **no refund**.

Purchase of health, baggage, and trip cancellation/interruption insurance is strongly recommended.
