Experience the wonderful landscape of the Oregon Coast, travel the old mail route up the Rouge River, explore the giant Redwood groves of Northern California, marvel at the beauty and majesty of Crater Lake, and enjoy the beauty and majesty of the Cascade Mountains on this 7 day small group adventure!

Day 1: Portland—Newport

Marine Discovery Tours. Afterward, you Arrive in Portland, Oregon by 3 PM. Meet will get to experience the joy of eating fresh fish right off the boat. The restaurants here are fantastic and this will be a treat! Lodging - Elizabeth Oceanfront Suites Newport, OR (B,L,D)

Day 3: Oregon Coast

Continue south along Oregon's beautiful coast. Some of the areas you will visit are Heceta Head Lighthouse, Sea Lion Caves, Devil's Churn, Thor's Wells, Captain Cook Point, Cape Blanco, and many others. The evening will be in Gold Beach, OR where you can spend your evening relaxing watching the waves, or enjoy a walk along

Day 4: Rogue River—Crescent City

Be ready this morning for more fun on the water – but this time it's the Rogue River. This thrilling 64-mile mail run on a Hydrojet Boat takes you through shallow riffles, beneath the sheer 400-foot walls of Copper Canyon. As you travel deeper into the federally designated Wild & Scenic River, make sure to have your camera ready to capture osprey, otter, deer and bear, as your professional guide shares the folklore, history, trees and wildflowers. Your adventure includes a

fantastic buffet lunch on an open deck overlooking the river or seated inside with views of the area. The afternoon will find you winding your way down the last part of the Oregon Coast and into Crescent City, California for the night.

Lodging – BW Northwood Inn, Crescent City, CA (B,L)

Day 5: Redwood Forests

After breakfast, you will have the opportunity to explore Redwood Forests of the Pacific Northwest. These include Prairie Creek Redwoods State Park, Del Norte Coast Redwoods State Park, and Jedediah Smith Redwood Grove, one of the best in the state. Once finished, you will then leave the coastal area and head

inland crossing back into Oregon. Lodging – Edgewater Inn Shady Cove, OR (B,L)

Day 6: Crater Lake—Bend

Travel inland to the mountains to explore Crater Lake NP. Crater Lake is widely known for its amazing depth, intense blue color, pure water, and spectacular views. You will enjoy views of the lake as you hike up to Garfield Peak, The Watchman and to Mt Scott for more views of the lake and the surrounding areas. Once you've said goodbye to Crater Lake, you'll make your way to Bend, OR for the evening. Lodging – Doubletree by Hilton Bend, OR (B, L)

Day 7: Columbia River Gorge—Portland

Today, you will explore Newberry Volcano National Monument to see an active volcanic area. Afterward, you will head north to Portland. You will travel through the Columbia River Gorge. Enjoy the breathtaking views of Multnomah Falls. You will have a farewell lunch at Multnomah Falls Lodge. We will arrive at the Portland Airport in the late afternoon. **(B,L)**
