

Grand Teton & Yellowstone Explorer

Learning about the unique ecological and geological history that continues to shape this area, how it came into existence, and see the plants and animals that call this wilderness home. Your adventure awaits!

From a land built on earthquakes, fire and other extreme geological forces, Grand Teton, Yellowstone and Craters of the Moon are now three unique ecosystems covering an area the size of New England. 14,000 ft peaks, broad valleys teeming with wildlife, glaciers, thermal features and barren landscapes are awaiting you.

Day 1: Arrive Salt Lake City, UT

Upon arrival to the airport and picking up your luggage, please use an Uber, taxi or airport shuttle to get you to the hotel on your own. You can arrive at any time today. When you get to the hotel, just give your name to the front desk and you will be checked into your hotel room for the evening. Once you settle in, feel free to explore Salt Lake City. There is a document attached to the Vamoos App that will give you some information about what to see and do while in the area! Lodging: Courtyard by Marriott Salt Lake City Downtown

Day 2: Salt Lake City—Jackson, WY

This morning your guide will pick you up at the hotel at 7:00 AM and you will depart for Jackson, WY. Learn about the unique geology and history of Northern Utah, Southeastern Idaho, and Western Wyoming on the way to Jackson, WY. Explore the Gros Ventre Slide area and historic Jackson. Dinner tonight will be on your own. There are several fantastic local restaurants in Jackson. Lodging: Elk Country Inn (B, L)

Day 3: Grand Teton

Today you will enter Grand Teton National Park and start your day with wildlife viewing and photography opportunities at Schwabacher Landing

for a boat ride across the lake and hiking to Hidden Falls and Inspiration Point. Next head north to Jackson Lake and Colter Bay for an afternoon of more hiking and wildlife watching. Return to Jackson for the evening and enjoy a group dinner at a local restaurant. National Park Lodging: Elk Country Inn (B,L,D)

Day 4: Jackson Yellowstone

Yellowstone NP and explore the West Thumb Geyser Basin, Yellowstone Lake, Hayden Valley, and the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone. You will then travel to the Norris Geyser Basin for hiking and

and Mormon Row. Arrive at Jenny Lake exploring before traveling through the Madison River Vallev Yellowstone. Enjoy a free evening to explore this western town. Lodging: Kelly Inn or similar (B,L)

Day 5: Northern Loop Yellowstone

You will start the day by traveling up and over Dunraven pass to experience your West highest point in the park. This morning will be filled with wildlife watching and Drive north through Grand Teton NP to hiking opportunities in the Tower-Roosevelt areas. Enjoy a picnic lunch at a scenic location before exploring the Mammoth Hot Springs area. The afternoon will consist of more scenic and wildlife stops as we continue to explore

Yellowstone's Northern Loop. Once we get back to West Yellowstone, enjoy another free evening to yourselves.

Lodging: Kelly Inn or similar (B, L)

Day 6: Yellowstone National Park

Today you will explore the main Geothermal area of Yellowstone NP. You will explore the Firehole Geyser Basin, Old Faithful, and the Old Faithful Lodge. Afterwards continue your way to Madison Junction with stops at Black Sand Basin, Grand Prismatic Spring, Firehole Geyser Basin, and other areas. There will be some great hikes and multiple opportunities to enjoy watching the wildlife within the park. Lodging: Kelly Inn or similar (B,L)

Day 7: West Yellowstone—Salt Lake City, UT

This morning will be spent exploring just outside of Yellowstone NP in Island Park with stops at Big Springs and Mesa Falls. Continue south through the potato fields of Idaho, the Bear River Bird Refuge and then along the shore of the Great Salt Lake. If time allows, enjoy a stop at the Bear River Bird Refuge or Antelope Island. You will return to Salt Lake City by 6:00 pm. Lodging: Courtyard by Marriott Salt Lake City Downtown (B,L)

Day 8: Departure

This morning if time allows you are free to explore Salt Lake City. When the time comes, you will transfer to the Salt Lake City Airport on your own to catch your flight home. (B)
